

Autumn Harmony (Versatile Knit Cowl)

Easy (Basic knitting knowledge required)

Finished Size

X 42" /106.7 cm

Materials

US size 17 (12mm) knitting needles

2 balls 50g / 35 metres, 100% pure wool, Hug, 1130 Oat-Chunky

2 balls 50g / 50 metres, 100% fine merino Snug, 1130 Oat-Chunky

2 balls 50g / 50 metres, 100% fine merino Snug, 1040 Calm-Chunky

Or accent color of your choice.

Note: The cowl pictured is 42"/106.7 cm in length. If you desire more length, purchase 3 balls of each color.

Stitch marker

Tapestry needle (large eye)

Abbreviations

k knit

p purl

st(s) stitch(es)

Co cast on

Bo bind off

Gauge

Not necessary for this project.

Co 12 sts (using 3 strands-one of each color)

Row 1 k

Row 2 p

Row 3 *k1, p1, repeat from * to end of row.

Row 4 p

Row 5 *p1, k1, repeat from* to end of row.

Row 6 p

Repeat these 6 rows for 42"/106.7 cm

B/o with 3 needle method OR b/o with the basic knit bind off (see Helpful Resources section on pg 3) Want to wear as a scarf? You won't have to join the ends together.

Finishing

Weave in all ends. Block if desired.

To Block

Always check the yarn's washing, drying, and ironing instructions before blocking. Dampen your knitted project and lay flat on blocking board or surface. Smooth to desired size and shape, and pin. Let dry undisturbed overnight or until dry.
