



Soaring on Lace and Cupid's Wings Valentine's Day Cowl

This is a delightfully decorative and comfortable cowl to wear all year round.

Intermediate (basic knowledge of knitting required along with intermediate stitches)

Finished Size

Adult one size fits most.

Circumference 22"/55.9 cm

Materials

US 8, (5.0mm) Straight Knitting Needles

1 skein Simply Soft Caron, 6oz, 170 grams, 315 yards/288 Meters, Autumn Red or color of choice. Substitute yarn of similar weight.

small white buttons (optional)

matching thread

sewing needle

tapestry needle

stitch markers

Gauge not necessary for this project.

Abbreviations

k knit

p purl

c/o cast on stitch(es)

K2tog knit 2 sts together

y/o yarnover; wrap yarn around right needle before inserting it into next stitch
sts stitch(es)

pssso pass over slipped stitch over a knitted or purled stitch

sl1 slip one st to right-hand needle without knitting or purling

c/o 29 sts

Knit first 6 rows

Row 7: p2, k2, p to last 4 sts, k2, p2.

Row 8: k2, p2, *1, k 2 tog, y/o, k1, y/o sl1, k1, pssso, k1; repeat * to last 4 sts, p2, k2.

Row 9: p 2 k2, p to last 4 sts, k2, p2.

Row 10: k 2, p2, *k2tog, y/o, k3, y/o, sl1, k1, pssso; repeat * to last 4 sts, p2, k2.

Repeat rows 7-10 for 22"/55.9 cm or desired length.

Join the two ends together using your preferred method (3 needle bind off or traditional bind off in pattern with 2 needles)

Weave in all ends.

Finish

Attach your decorative button(s) (or your choice of brooch, shawl pin, etc) along the first 6 knit rows and space them as needed.
